

National WMF Projects

Our purpose, as stated before, is “To awaken and deepen interest in and love for the kingdom of God, at home and abroad, and sharing the great missionary enterprise of the Christian Church through:

- a. monthly WMF bible studies.
- b. the distribution of literature and information concerning the missions of the Women’s Missionary Federation.
- c. Personal involvement and financial contributions to the ministries of the Association of Free Lutheran Congregations through its regularly established boards.

To unite all the women of the Association of Free Lutheran Congregations into the deeper fellowship of consecrated service for the missions, the charities, and the Christian Education program of our Association.

To organize missionary activities and children’s missionary groups wherever possible.

With this in mind, WMF offerings go to four general missions

- **Christian Education**
- **World Missions**
- **Home Missions**
- **WMF General Fund**

The WMF budget is approved at the annual WMF conference. A copy of the current budget can be obtained by contacting the National WMF Treasurer. WMF members are encouraged to pray for each aspect of ministry, that there would be an awakening and a deeper love for the Kingdom of God at home and abroad.

Contributions from local and district WMFs should be mailed directly to the National WMF Treasurer who will distribute monies to the designated ministry of the month or according to the instructions of your local WMF. In order that your group receives proper recognition for all monetary gifts, please send all your “special/designated” gifts through the National WMF Treasurer. She will forward it wherever you indicate on your transmittal form. **Transmittal forms may be requested from the National WMF Treasurer.**

The WMF is a unique arm of the AFLC in that 3/4 of our projects are in support of other departments. The projects are **Christian Education** (Parish Ed, FLBC, FLS), **Home Missions**, **World Missions** and **WMF General Fund**. All funding that comes in for the Christian Education, Home Missions and World Missions projects is sent to these projects. The WMF General Fund is our working fund and is the only budgeted fund. (April, August, and December)

The support will be distributed to the AFLC missionaries as the World Missions Board deems necessary. Please keep aware of the missionaries that are on the field and those who are no longer serving on the mission field, so that funding sent to World Missions can be used appropriately. Keep our missionaries and families in prayer. We also have under this project: **1) Mission Scholarship** program which is available to seminarians who are approved as missionary candidates for AFLC World Missions, Missionary Assistant, and Missionary and Seminary wives who desire to continue their spiritual education. **2) Missionary Assistants Fund:** for individuals approved by the AFLC Missions Board to help serve our missionaries on the field. Support received for the WMF General Fund will be used to cover necessary expenses. Support also covers the administrative costs, salary for the Executive Secretary and stipends for the President and Treasurer and other expenses such as convention expenses, travel of officers, office equipment and supplies, communications between District and National officers.
